

A common model railway problem:

- A twelve-coach OO-scale model express train is about 3.4 metres long (ca. 11 feet).
- The average UK house has no room big enough for such a train or long freight train to run realistically on a model railway and often loft space is cramped.

A possible solution:

- Find a big enough building somewhere.
- Build a big OO-scale model railway in it.
- Share it with the general public.



A possible solution:

Late 2006:

- Contact with DCC.
- Offered same building.
- Markeaton Park footfall over 1,000,000 annually.



- DCC to continue to own building
- FT Ltd. to lease building
- FT Ltd. to upgrade and maintain building
- Lease to be 15 years
- Peppercorn rent

Towards a building

Estimates for building upgrade:

• Best was £156,000 from Bull Contracting near Ashbourne

Need for grants to pay for upgrade!


In 2012 we built our Darley Green exhibition model railway in five months.



- And much, much more!
























Signals at Darley Green

- Operated when points set for passenger shuttles
 Two trains in one loop
- One loop on each Chinley circuit
- As one train leaves the loop, the next moves up.
- Enabled up to eight trains to run on Chinley layout without operator involvement.








